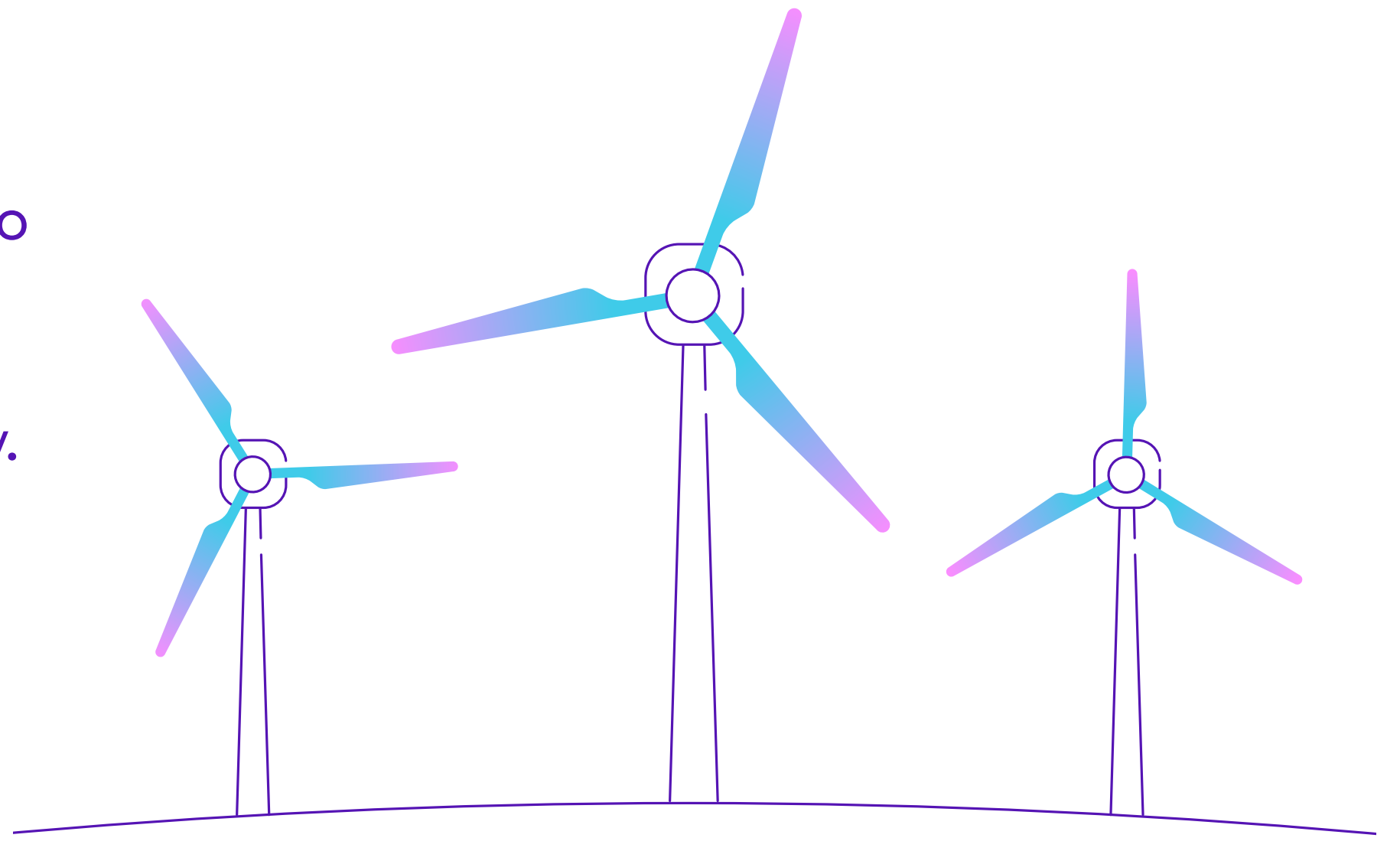
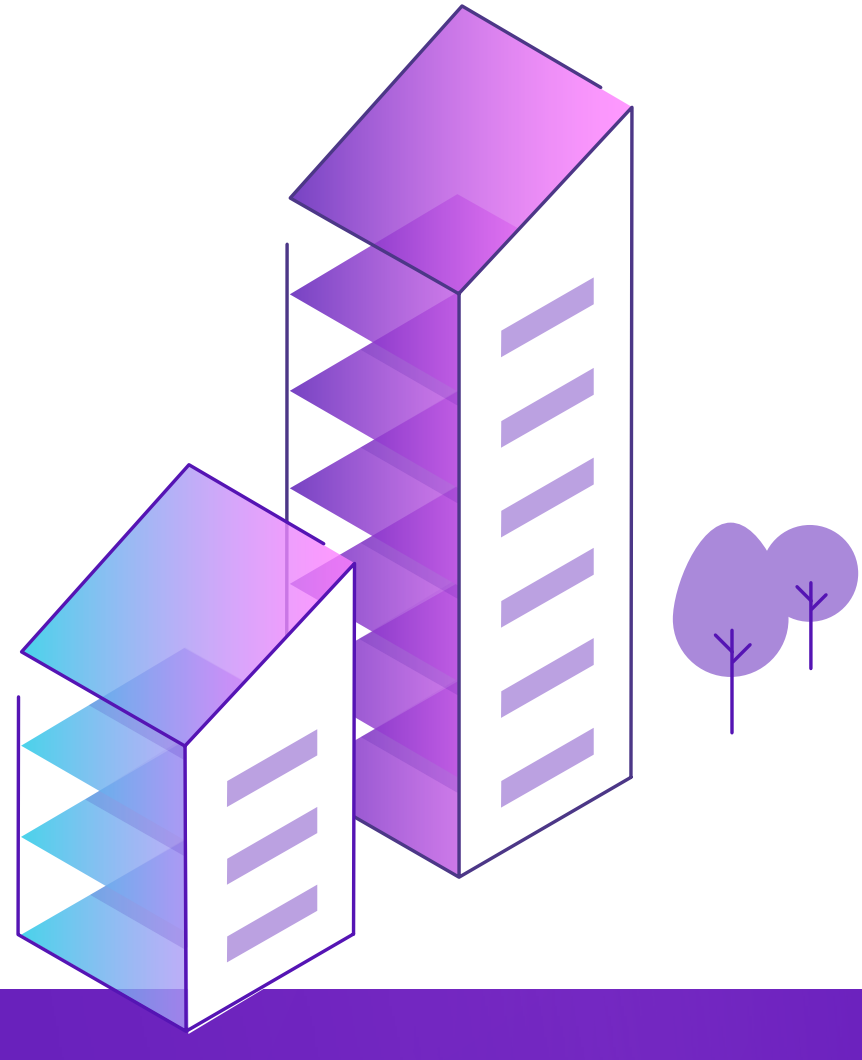

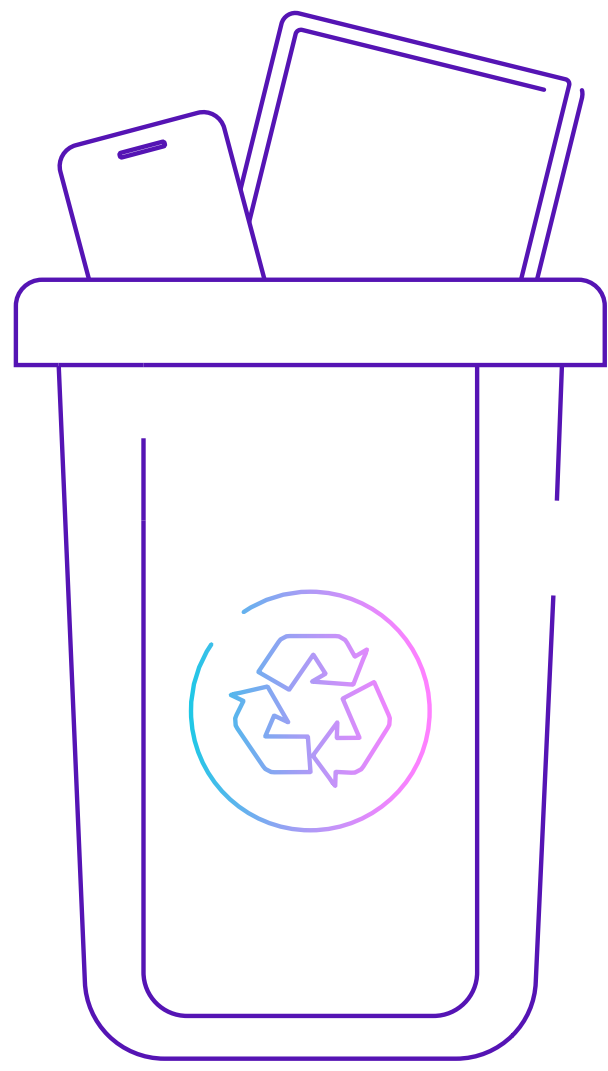

This is being driven by new regulations, pressures from investors and customers, market conditions and the continued fallout from the energy crisis.

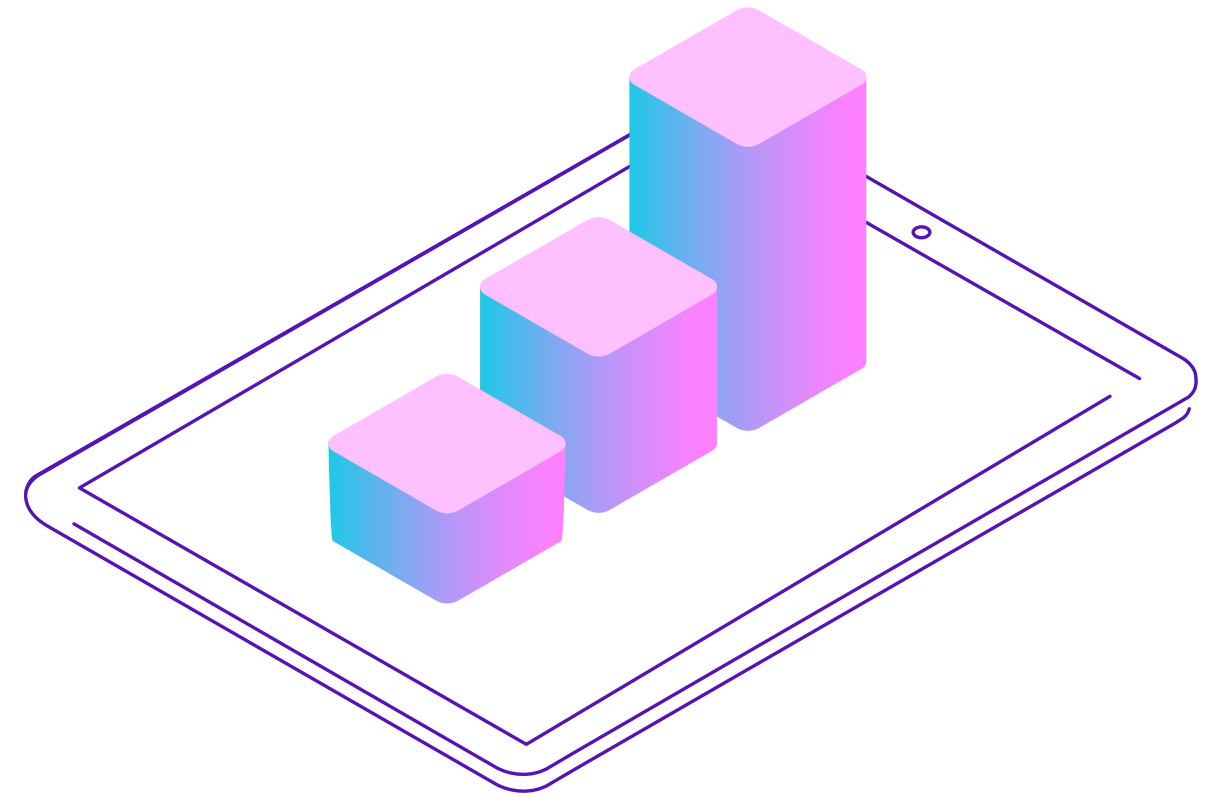
